#### Eligibility

- All members of the Carolinas Region are eligible except for members of the CRESS committee.
- The applicant must be a Carolinas Region member at the time the scholarship is applied for and awarded.
- The applicant may not have received a CRESS within the previous 5 years.

#### **Application Requirements**

- All information requested on the application form must be provided. A letter providing the same information is acceptable.
- Send the completed form to the education coordinator by mail postmarked on or before May 1, or by email dated no later than May 1.

#### **Eligible Class**

- Any class consistent with EGA learning except for a Carolinas Region seminar class.
- Must be held during the year the award is made.
- The award may be applied to the class fee and other expenses of attending the class.

#### **Optional Sharing**

Scholarship recipients are encouraged, but not required, to share their class experience with members by making a presentation at a region meeting, writing an article for the region newsletter, or teaching a class at a region or chapter educational event.
